medical treatment deemed necessary, and offering settlements that fall short of covering long-term medical needs and lost income. Injured workers who navigate this process without legal representation are at a significant disadvantage from the start.

In some cases, a third-party personal injury claim may exist alongside the workers' compensation claim, providing an additional avenue for recovery that many injured workers are unaware of.

Augusta is home to a significant workforce in manufacturing, healthcare, construction, and logistics, and workers in these industries face real and ongoing risk of serious workplace injuries.
