



Hansen & Harmon Injury Law Ranked Top 3% of Nevada Attorneys in Nevada Business Magazine

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Hansen & Harmon Injury Law, a personal injury practice handling slip and fall and broader premises liability claims for clients throughout Henderson, has been included among Nevada's Top 3% Ranked Attorneys in Nevada Business Magazine's 2025 "Top Rank Attorneys" listing. The recognition is peer-nominated and ranked, and highlights their commitment to represent injured visitors, residents, and workers across the Green Valley, Anthem, and MacDonald Ranch areas of the Henderson submarket.

The Nevada Business Magazine listing identifies attorneys who meet a threshold of peer nomination and active standing with the State Bar of Nevada, and it cites the top three percent of licensed Nevada lawyers in its 2025 edition. Hansen & Harmon Injury Law provides slip and fall representation for people injured on retail, grocery, hotel, casino, and residential property across Henderson, Nevada, drawing on more than thirty years of personal injury and trial experience that the practice carries into premises liability work. The firm's caseload here spans grocery and big-box retail floor incidents, hotel and casino property injuries, swimming pool and pool-deck accidents, and stair and step-up incidents in apartment and condominium communities.

Premises liability claims in this market reflect the area's particular mix of master-planned residential development, larger-format retail, and proximity to the Las Vegas Strip's hospitality industry. Green Valley, Anthem, and the surrounding Henderson communities draw retirees and families who shop in suburban centers where slick floors, transition mats, parking-lot tripping hazards, and pool-deck surfaces produce a recurring pattern of injury claims. Hotel and casino property injuries also enter the practice from clients who live locally and were injured on commercial properties elsewhere in the valley, where photographs of the scene, incident reports, and surveillance preservation become central within the first hours and days.

Amanda A. Harmon, Managing Partner at the firm and a recipient of the CALI Award in Torts at the William S. Boyd School of Law at UNLV, said the Nevada Business Magazine recognition reflects how the firm is regarded across the Nevada legal community. "What sets this listing apart is that it's peer-nominated and tied to active bar standing, not paid placement or advertising spend," Harmon said. "We see slip and fall and premises cases turn on details that disappear if no one is acting on them in the first week. Incident reports get filed late, surveillance loops over, witness names stop being available. Our posture is to treat every premises case as one that may be tried, and to build the evidence record from day one as if it will be."

Evidence preservation sits at the practical heart of how the firm approaches its slip and fall and broader premises liability work. The State Bar of Nevada admits the firm's attorneys, and the practice handles slip and fall representation on a contingency basis with free initial consultations conducted in either English or Spanish through its bilingual office, consistent with plaintiff-side personal injury practice in the state. Cases typically open with a request for the property's incident report, retention of surveillance video before it overwrites, photographic documentation of the hazard before remediation, identification of the maintenance and inspection schedule on the relevant area of the premises, and medical-records collection that connects the injury to a documented timeline.

The Henderson submarket presents its own set of premises liability patterns the firm regularly encounters. Apartment and condominium complexes in Green Valley and Anthem generate stair-and-handrail incidents and pool-deck injuries that turn on the property manager's inspection records. Retail and grocery floor incidents in the area's suburban centers produce cases where the spill-response logbook and the in-store camera coverage are dispositive, while older single-family neighborhoods around MacDonald Ranch produce sidewalk and walkway tripping cases that involve municipal as well as private liability questions.

Premises liability work also intersects with the firm's broader trial-readiness posture, recognized separately in other peer-based listings the firm carries. The practice prepares each slip and fall file with trial in mind rather than relying on settlement pressure, consistent with the trial-experience standing reflected in those listings. The Nevada Business Magazine 2025 listing is consistent with that practice profile and with the firm's emphasis on attorneys, rather than non-attorney staff, handling the case from intake through resolution.

The recognition arrives during a period of broader visibility for the practice under the Hansen & Harmon Injury Law name following its 2025 rebrand.
