The legal strategy varies significantly depending on whether an individual is pursuing an affirmative or defensive claim. Affirmative asylum cases are filed directly with U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, involving an interview with an asylum officer. Defensive asylum, on the other hand, occurs when an individual faces removal proceedings before an immigration court, requiring a formal defense before an immigration judge. Beyond immediate protection from deportation, a successful asylum claim provides a direct path toward long-term stability, allowing individuals to obtain work authorization, petition for qualifying family members, and eventually apply for a green card and U.S. citizenship.
