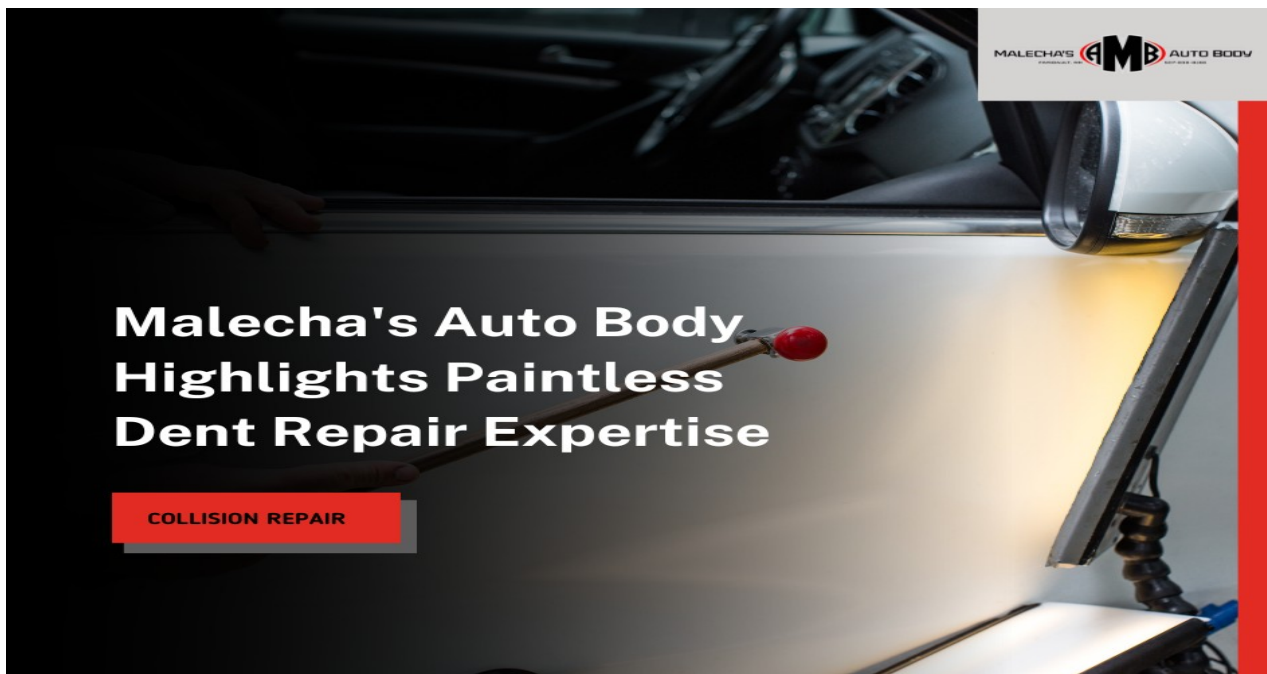




Malecha's Auto Body Highlights Paintless Dent Repair Expertise
