



## Jump Around Party Rentals Publishes Free Water Slide Selection Guide for Greater Austin Families Ahead of Summer Booking Season

Jump Around Party Rentals, a full-service party and event rental company serving the Greater Austin Metropolitan Area, has released a free online guide designed to help families and event planners choose the right water slide rental before they book. The guide, titled "How to Choose a Water Slide Rental for Your Greater Austin Party," is available now on the company website and addresses the most common questions Central Texas customers ask each summer.

The resource arrives ahead of the region's peak water slide booking window, which typically runs from May through September. According to the company, picking the wrong unit is one of the most frequent booking mistakes families make. A slide too small for the age group, too large for the yard, or reserved for a month when the water is simply too cold can all undercut an event that took weeks to plan.

"After more than fifteen years of setting up water slides in backyards across Central Texas, we kept

answering the same handful of questions over and over," said William Gann, owner of Jump Around Party Rentals. "Families were guessing at what would fit and what their kids would actually enjoy, and sometimes they guessed wrong. We decided to put every answer in one place so nobody has to find out on party day that a slide is too steep for the little ones or too big for the yard."

The guide is organized around the practical decisions a customer faces before reserving a unit. It opens with a size-by-age breakdown, matching slide heights from 18 feet through 32 feet to the crowd they suit best. Smaller slides in the 18-to-22-foot range are presented as purpose-built for elementary-age children, while the tallest units are framed as speed-focused attractions better suited to teens and adults. The company stresses that age group should drive the decision first, with overall size as a secondary consideration.

From there, the guide walks readers through single-lane versus double-lane formats, explaining that a double lane introduces a side-by-side racing element that raises repeat-ride rates and moves waiting lines faster at larger parties. It also compares standalone water slides against wet combo bounce houses, helping customers decide whether slide height and speed or a mix of bouncing and sliding delivers better value for their particular event.

Yard space receives its own detailed treatment. The guide notes that a 22-foot slide does not fit in a 22-foot yard, because the required footprint includes the landing pool, the run-out area and side clearance. A 22-foot unit typically needs a 15-by-42-foot clear flat area, and a 27-foot unit needs roughly 15 by 50 feet. The company also highlights overhead clearance as a frequently overlooked limitation, pointing out that mature oak and pecan canopy in established Central Texas neighborhoods often restricts vertical space more than the ground dimensions do.

Seasonal timing is treated as a core planning factor rather than an afterthought. The guide presents a month-by-month verdict tuned to Central Texas weather, identifying May as the peak booking month and recommending morning-only scheduling through the hottest stretch of June, July and August. It advises against water slides from October through February, when cooler water temperatures make the experience uncomfortable, and points customers toward dry inflatables, obstacle courses and mechanical rides for fall and winter events.

The safety and preparation guidance reflects the company's positioning as a rental provider that treats setup, supervision and inspection as central to its work. The guide details water and power access requirements, including the need for a garden hose bib within 50 feet of the slide and a dedicated 110-volt outlet within 100 feet. A setup-day checklist covers clearing the area, confirming utilities, watering hardened soil the night before, and stationing adults at both the top of the slide and the splash-pool exit during operation. It also advises operators to monitor weather radar in summer and deflate immediately if winds exceed 25 miles per hour.

"The equipment is only half of a good water slide day," Gann said. "The other half is knowing where the hose is, keeping an adult at the top and the bottom, scheduling around the afternoon heat, and watching the weather. None of that is complicated once somebody tells you, and that is exactly what this guide does. We would rather a family read it and book the right unit than book fast and be disappointed."

The guide closes with a frequently asked questions section written around the exact phrasing customers use when searching online, covering topics such as the right slide size for a children's birthday party, how much yard space a unit requires, and whether a water slide makes sense for an October event in Austin. Interlinked resources address outdoor-event heat planning and the differences between bounce houses and combo units.

Jump Around Party Rentals delivers water slides ranging from 18 to 32 feet to backyard parties, school field days, graduation events and community gatherings across Williamson County, Travis County, Bell County and the broader Austin Metropolitan Area. The company is inspected under the Texas Department of Insurance amusement ride program, is fully insured, and holds a 4.76-star average across 975 verified reviews. It has been owner-operated since 2008.

The water slide selection guide is available at no cost on the Jump Around Party Rentals website. Families can browse available units or confirm which slide fits their yard and crowd by calling the company directly.
