



All Pro Thornton Deck Builders Extends Custom Deck Services to Lafayette

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All Pro Thornton Deck Builders has extended its custom deck design and construction services to homeowners in Lafayette, Colorado, giving residents of the Boulder County community direct access to a regional contractor that has spent years building outdoor living structures across the north Denver metropolitan area. The service expansion took effect this quarter and covers new deck construction, deck replacement, structural repair, and related outdoor living additions throughout Lafayette and adjacent neighborhoods.

The move reflects sustained residential construction activity along the U.S. 287 corridor between Broomfield and Longmont, a stretch that includes Lafayette, Louisville, and Erie. Lafayette alone has grown to a population of roughly 30,000, and the city has issued a steady volume of residential remodeling permits over the past several construction seasons as older housing stock reaches the point where original decks require replacement. By extending coverage into the market, All Pro Thornton Deck Builders is responding to inquiries from Lafayette property owners who previously had to work with contractors based farther east in Adams County.

The extended services include design consultation, permit coordination with the City of Lafayette, and construction of decks built from pressure-treated lumber, cedar, redwood, and composite materials such as Trex, TimberTech, and Fibron. The company also handles ancillary work including pergolas, railings, stairs, and deck lighting, and it repairs storm-damaged and aging structures that no longer meet current International Residential Code standards for load capacity, guardrail height, or ledger attachment. All estimates for Lafayette projects are provided on site, and the company follows the same insured and permitted workflow used across its existing service area.

"The extension into Lafayette formalizes work that has already been happening on a project-by-project basis, and it allows the crew to schedule Boulder County jobs alongside projects in Thornton, Westminster, and Broomfield without treating them as one-off travel jobs," said David Miller, Owner of All Pro Thornton Deck Builders. He added that pricing, warranty terms, and material sourcing for Lafayette homeowners will match what the company offers in its core service area.

Lafayette has a mix of housing types that shapes the kind of deck work most commonly requested. Neighborhoods such as Indian Peaks, Centaur Village, and Beacon Hill contain single-family homes built between the late 1970s and the early 2000s, many of which have original wood decks that are now between twenty and forty years old. Industry service-life estimates from the North American Deck and Railing Association place the functional lifespan of a typical pressure-treated deck at ten to fifteen years and cedar decks at fifteen to twenty years, meaning a substantial portion of the local inventory is at or past the point of replacement. Composite decking, which carries longer manufacturer warranties, has become a common replacement choice in the area because of Colorado's intense ultraviolet exposure and wide temperature swings.

Permitting is another factor behind the extension. The City of Lafayette requires a building permit for any deck attached to a residence or elevated more than thirty inches above grade, and inspections are handled through the municipal building division rather than through Boulder County. All Pro Thornton Deck Builders will help with filing the permits directly on behalf of Lafayette clients and coordinate the required footing, framing, and final inspections, a process that Miller said reduces the administrative burden on homeowners unfamiliar with local code requirements.

The company reports that initial demand from Lafayette has centered on full deck rebuilds rather than new construction, consistent with the age of the local housing stock. Project timelines typically range from two to four weeks for standard residential decks, depending on material availability and inspection scheduling, with composite projects taking slightly longer because of lead times on specialty boards and railing systems. Seasonal booking for spring and summer construction is already underway, and the company expects Lafayette projects to make up a meaningful share of its 2026 residential workload.

Miller said the extension is intended as a long-term commitment to the Lafayette market rather than a temporary service radius adjustment, and that follow-up warranty service and repair work will be handled under the same terms extended to homeowners in the company's original service area.
