



South Shore Basement Finishing Expands Residential Service Area to Randolph

QUINCY, MA - August 14, 2026 -

South Shore Basement Finishing Company has extended its residential remodeling services into Randolph, Massachusetts, giving homeowners in the town direct access to a Massachusetts-based contractor that specializes exclusively in basement conversions. The expansion took effect this year and covers design consultation, full basement finishing, egress compliance work, and structural moisture control.

Randolph is a town of roughly 34,000 residents in Norfolk County, with a housing stock dominated by mid-twentieth-century single-family homes and split-level properties that frequently include unfinished lower levels. The company's move into the area follows a rise in inquiry volume from Randolph residents over the past eighteen months, according to internal records maintained by the firm. Formal service coverage now places Randolph within the same operational footprint as neighboring towns already served across Norfolk and Plymouth counties.

Under the expanded service area, projects in Randolph will follow the same scope of work available to existing clients throughout the South Shore. That scope covers framing, insulation, egress window installation where required by state code, electrical rough-in coordinated with licensed subcontractors, and finish work

that includes flooring, ceilings, and built-in storage. Each project also includes preparation of documentation required for permit submission to the Randolph Building Department, along with inspection scheduling handled directly by the contractor rather than the homeowner.

"The decision to formalize service in Randolph reflects a pattern of demand that has been building for several quarters," said Susan Snow, Owner of South Shore Basement Finishing Company. "The town's housing profile aligns closely with the type of properties the company has been finishing for more than a decade, and dedicated coverage allows for shorter response times, consistent crew assignments, and pricing that reflects local project conditions rather than out-of-region overhead."

Basement finishing in Massachusetts is regulated under the state building code and the Board of Building Regulations and Standards, which sets minimum standards for ceiling height, egress openings, smoke and carbon monoxide detection, and moisture management in below-grade living space. Homes built before 1978 also fall under the federal Renovation, Repair, and Painting Rule administered by the Environmental Protection Agency, which governs disturbance of lead-based paint. Compliance with those requirements is included in the project scope offered to Randolph homeowners at no separate cost.

The Massachusetts basement remodeling market has been shaped in recent years by rising home values in the Greater Boston area, which have encouraged existing owners to add usable square footage rather than relocate. Data from the National Association of Home Builders and industry cost reports published by Remodeling magazine indicate that basement finishing projects typically return between 70 and 75 percent of their cost at resale, a figure that has held relatively stable through changing interest rate cycles. Finished lower levels are frequently converted into family rooms, home offices, guest suites, and multigenerational living space, uses that have gained further traction since 2020.

The company reports that projects in the newly covered territory will be coordinated from its existing operations base and staffed by the same crews assigned to nearby communities, including Braintree, Weymouth, Milton, and Quincy. Scheduling for initial consultations in the town opened during the summer season, with construction start dates available in the following quarter. Homeowners interested in service can request a consultation through the company's Randolph service page, which outlines project stages, code considerations, and typical timelines for the region.

South Shore Basement Finishing Company operates as a single-focus specialty contractor, meaning basement conversions are the only category of work performed. That structure allows for standardized workflow across projects and continuity between the estimating, design, and construction phases. The Randolph expansion is the company's most recent territorial addition in Norfolk County and follows earlier service extensions in adjacent communities during prior years.
