Because the treatment usually requires little or no removal of healthy enamel, it is regarded as a conservative approach to improving the appearance of a smile while maintaining natural tooth structure.

Consultations are designed to provide patients with clear and personalised information before any treatment begins. Appointments generally include an assessment of oral health, a discussion about cosmetic concerns, an examination of the teeth and bite, and advice regarding the most suitable options based on clinical findings. Patients are also able to discuss expected outcomes, treatment stages, maintenance requirements and any alternative cosmetic treatments that may better suit their needs.

Instead, it is commonly recommended for suitable patients seeking modest cosmetic refinements that complement their natural smile. Each treatment plan is based on individual clinical findings rather than a standard approach, ensuring recommendations remain appropriate for long-term oral health.

The broader value of cosmetic dentistry has also been recognised in published research. Schmidt and Tatum, writing in the study 'Cosmetic dentistry' published in *Current Opinion in Otolaryngology & Head and Neck Surgery* (2006), noted that treatments including cosmetic bonding, teeth whitening, veneers, crowns and gingival contouring can effectively improve dental aesthetics by addressing concerns such as discolouration, asymmetry and alignment. The authors observed that while orthodontic treatment continues to play an important role, less invasive cosmetic procedures can often deliver satisfying improvements within a relatively short period, contributing to greater patient confidence, wellbeing and satisfaction with their smile.
