Conveyancing is the legal process through which ownership of property is transferred from one party to another. The process begins after the contract of sale is signed by both buyer and seller, followed by the

searches and enquiries needed to confirm the details of a property, the resolution of any issues those enquiries identify, and the eventual settlement. Buyers and sellers benefit from the guidance of a conveyancer or property solicitor throughout the process.

Searches and enquiries form part of the process and are generally used to confirm details about a property before a transaction is completed. These may include checks relating to the property's title, any registered interests affecting it, and information held by local authorities. The findings from these enquiries are typically reviewed as part of preparing a matter for settlement and can be relevant to how a transaction proceeds.

Settlement represents the final stage of a conveyancing matter. At settlement, the legal ownership of the property passes to the buyer. In the lead-up to this point, the parties confirm that the conditions of the contract have been satisfied, transfer documents are prepared and checked, and arrangements are coordinated with any financial institutions involved. Following settlement, the transfer of ownership is lodged for registration so that the change of title is formally recorded.

Property transactions continue to take place across the region throughout the year, and conveyancing is a necessary step in each of them. A stable base of operations allows a Conveyancing Brisbane practice to manage these transactions consistently, from the initial consultation through to settlement. The relocation is intended to support that continuity as the practice carries out its work at the new location.

For many individuals, the purchase or sale of a home is amongst the larger financial transactions they will undertake, and conveyancing provides the legal framework through which that transaction is completed. The process typically brings together several parties; each has a defined role in ensuring that the transfer of ownership is carried out correctly and that the terms agreed in the contract are met.
