



Amana Care Clinic Expands Diagnostic Capabilities Across Davenport Area Locations

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DAVENPORT, Iowa - July 14, 2026 -

Amana Care Clinic has expanded diagnostic capabilities and medical services across its three Iowa locations in Davenport, Bettendorf, and Muscatine in response to increased regional demand for walk-in medical care. The expansion includes enhanced laboratory testing equipment and updated diagnostic protocols implemented at all three facilities.

The urgent care clinic locations have added comprehensive diagnostic services including expanded blood testing panels, advanced imaging capabilities, and rapid testing protocols for common infections. The expansion addresses a 25 percent increase in walk-in patient volume reported across the Quad Cities region during the past quarter, according to regional healthcare data.

"The expansion of our diagnostic capabilities allows us to provide comprehensive medical evaluations for a broader range of conditions," said Moutaz Kotob, PhD, Medical Director at Amana Care Clinic. "These enhancements reduce the need for patients to visit a hospital or multiple facilities for testing and treatment."

The clinic's expanded services now encompass treatment for fractures, lacerations, respiratory infections, urinary tract infections, and seasonal illnesses. Laboratory capabilities include complete blood counts, metabolic panels, strep testing, flu testing, and urinalysis. X-ray services are available on-site at all three locations for immediate imaging needs.

Regional healthcare data indicates that approximately 40 percent of emergency room visits involve non-critical conditions that could be addressed at walk-in medical facilities. The Iowa Department of Public Health reports that access to walk-in clinics reduces hospital emergency department utilization for non-emergency conditions, allowing hospitals to allocate resources to critical care patients.

Amana Care Clinic's Davenport location serves as the primary facility for the region, with the Bettendorf and Muscatine locations providing additional coverage for surrounding communities. Each facility operates with certified medical professionals trained in urgent care protocols and equipped to handle non-life-threatening medical conditions.

The clinic treats a range of conditions including abrasions, burns, ear infections, sinus infections, joint pain, muscle injuries, and childhood illnesses. Additional services include wound care follow-up, suture removal, sports physicals, and fish hook removal. The facilities maintain online check-in systems allowing patients to reserve their place in line before arrival.

Healthcare industry analysis shows that walk-in clinics have become an integral component of community healthcare infrastructure, particularly in managing seasonal health concerns and providing accessible medical care outside traditional office hours. The American College of Emergency Physicians reports that urgent care facilities handle approximately 89 million visits annually nationwide.

Amana Care Clinic operates as a walk-in medical facility providing non-emergency healthcare services to Iowa communities. The clinic maintains three locations throughout the Quad Cities region, offering diagnostic services, treatment for minor injuries and illnesses, and preventive care services. The facilities serve both individual patients and local businesses requiring occupational health services.
