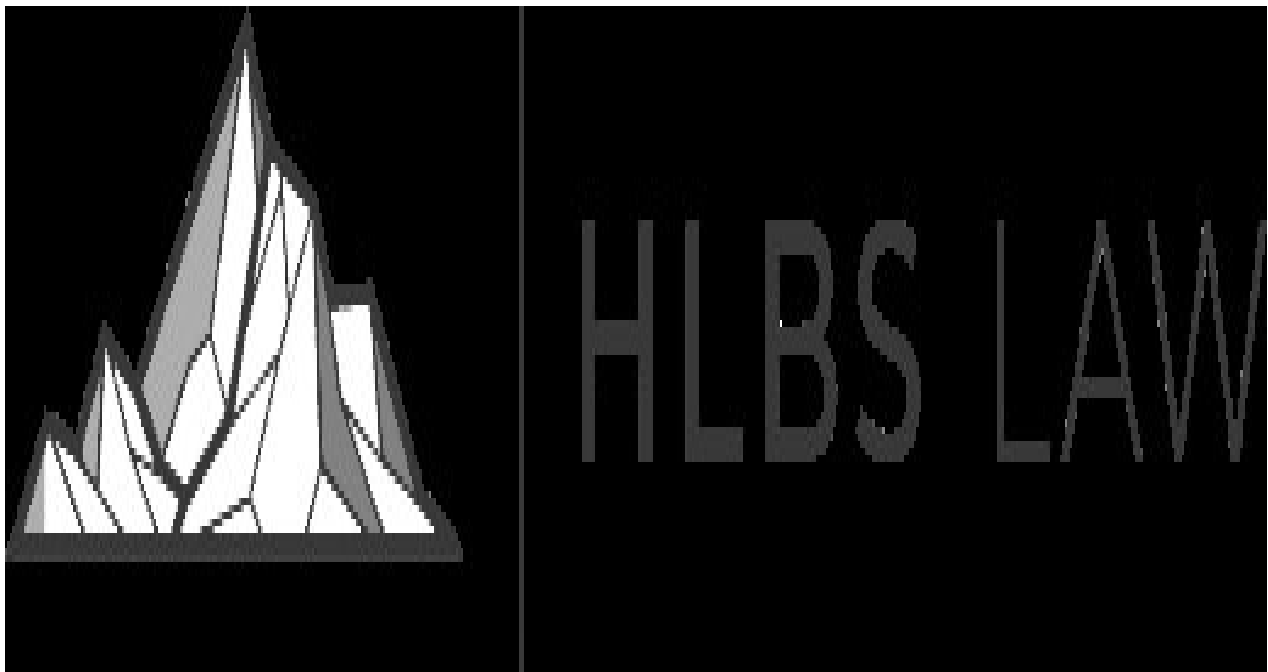




HLBS Law Announces Support for Three Non-Profit Organizations Serving Communities Nationwide
