Christian Community Homes & Services is celebrating 45 years of providing compassionate, faith-based care to seniors in western Wisconsin. The milestone marks the organization's growth from a single skilled nursing facility to two comprehensive campuses offering a full continuum of senior living options.

Founded in 1981 by the Hudson United Methodist Church and supported by the local Hudson community, Christian Community Homes & Services emerged from a grassroots effort to preserve essential nursing home services in the area. What began as a modest initiative has evolved into a nonprofit organization dedicated to nurturing graceful living rooted in Christian principles. The upcoming 45th anniversary event, titled "Cruisin' Through the Years," will take place on July 29, 2026, at the Hudson campus, inviting residents, staff, families, and community members to reflect on the organization's history and impact.

Over the past four and a half decades, Christian Community Homes & Services has expanded its services to meet the changing needs of seniors. The Hudson campus now includes Willow Glen for skilled nursing and transitional care and rehabilitation, Pine Ridge for assisted living, Pine Ridge Gardens for secure memory care, and WinterGreen for independent senior apartments. The Osceola campus, located adjacent

to the Osceola Medical Center, provides skilled nursing, transitional care and rehabilitation, and assisted living with convenient covered access to medical services.

This development reflects the organization's commitment to offering personalized care across different levels of need. Residents benefit from individualized care plans developed in collaboration with families and healthcare providers, alongside spiritual support through worship services, Bible studies, and pastoral care. The faith-centered approach, combined with practical daily assistance, creates an environment where seniors can maintain dignity and purpose.

Pamela Klingfus, CEO of Christian Community Homes & Services, reflected on the anniversary. "Reaching this 45-year milestone is a testament to the vision of our founders and the dedication of generations of staff, volunteers, and community supporters who have sustained our mission."

The organization operates under core values of integrity, accountability, respect, compassion, and humor. These principles guide every aspect of operations, from clinical care to life enrichment activities. Volunteers play a significant role in enhancing resident experiences through intergenerational programs, pet therapy, music, and community events, strengthening connections between the campuses and the broader St. Croix Valley area.

The Christian Community Campus Foundation supports the organization's work by directing donations toward resident assistance, equipment upgrades, staff development via the Helping Hands Scholarship, and program enhancements. This financial backbone has enabled Christian Community Homes & Services to maintain high standards while addressing the growing demand for quality senior living communities in the region.

As demographic trends show an increasing senior population in St. Croix County, the organization continues to adapt. Recent campus improvements at Hudson, including updates to dining areas and expansion of assisted living capacity, demonstrate ongoing investment in facilities that support resident well-being. These efforts align with the original community-driven spirit that launched the organization in 1981.

Leadership at both campuses emphasizes continuity and innovation. Administrators and directors, many of whom have advanced through internal roles, bring deep institutional knowledge and a shared commitment to resident-centered care. This stability has contributed to recognitions such as the Newsweek ranking for the Hudson campus and local honors for the Osceola location.

The 45th anniversary celebration provides an opportunity to honor the past while looking toward the future. Events like "Cruisin' Through the Years" highlight the journeys of residents and staff who have been part of the organization's story. Through music, storytelling, and shared memories, participants will celebrate the

lives touched and the community built over 45 years.

Christian Community Homes & Services remains focused on its founding mission of serving individuals in ways that reflect the importance of each unique life. As a nonprofit, faith-based provider, the organization relies on community partnerships and the generosity of supporters to sustain and expand its programs.
