after," said Nate Chandler, Owner at Aloha Pavers & Concrete. "Poor base compaction, insufficient excavation depth, and inadequate drainage planning account for the majority of cracking and shifting problems we see in residential concrete surfaces throughout Utah County."

Common issues affecting concrete surfaces in Utah include cracking from freeze-thaw cycles, shifting due to unstable base materials, pooling water from improper grading, surface deterioration from de-icing salts, and premature wear from inadequate curing processes. These problems affect not only the appearance of concrete surfaces but also create safety hazards and reduce property values.

The educational initiative emphasizes the importance of proper planning for each type of concrete surface. Driveways require specific base depths and reinforcement to handle vehicle loads, while patios need careful attention to drainage slopes and expansion joints. Walkways and steps demand precise grading to ensure safe navigation and water management, particularly during winter months.

Aloha Pavers & Concrete in Orem has developed comprehensive installation protocols that address each critical factor in concrete longevity. These protocols include excavation to proper depths based on soil conditions and intended use, installation of compacted base materials to prevent settling, strategic placement of control joints to manage inevitable cracking, proper slope calculations for effective drainage, and appropriate curing techniques for maximum strength development.

"Every concrete project requires careful consideration of both immediate needs and long-term performance," added Chandler. "Whether installing a new driveway or creating an outdoor living space, the decisions made during planning and installation will determine whether that surface lasts five years or fifty."
