



Cheese Removals and Transport Expands Operations with Relocation to New Brighton and Hove Premises

Cheese Removals and Transport has announced the relocation of its operations to new premises in Brighton and Hove, marking an important milestone in the company's development as it continues to support residential moves across Sussex and the wider United Kingdom. The move sees the family-run removals business transition from its previous base at 37 Furze Hill House, Furze Hill, to a new location at 3 Fernwood Rise, Brighton and Hove, Brighton BN1 5ER.

The relocation reflects the company's ongoing efforts to ensure its operations remain aligned with the demands of a growing customer base across Brighton, Hove, Worthing, Portslade, Haywards Heath, Hassocks, and surrounding communities. By moving to new premises, Cheese Removals and Transport aims to support the day-to-day coordination of its removal services while maintaining its focus on practical, organised moving solutions for households throughout the region.

Operated by brothers Luca and Alessio Giambrone, Cheese Removals and Transport has established itself

as a local removals provider serving a wide range of residential moving requirements. The business offers apartment removals, completion-day removals, home and family removals, and national relocations, with services designed to accommodate various property types, moving schedules, and travel distances.

The decision to relocate was made following a review of the company's operational requirements and future plans. As the business has continued to support an increasing number of local and long-distance moves, the need for premises better suited to ongoing administration, planning, and logistical coordination became a key consideration. The new location provides a dedicated base from which the company can continue organising removals across Sussex and beyond.

Luca Giambrone said the move represents an important step for the business. "Relocating to new premises gives the company a base that supports the way operations are managed on a daily basis. The move provides an opportunity to continue developing internal processes while maintaining the same approach to residential removals that customers have come to expect."

The company's services cover a broad range of moving requirements. Apartment removals remain an important part of the business, particularly within Brighton and Hove, where many residential properties are located within apartment buildings, converted houses, and developments with restricted access. These moves often require detailed planning around parking, stair access, and building regulations.

Completion day removals also continue to form a significant part of the company's work. These moves require flexibility due to the timing of property transactions, as access to a property depends on legal completion. By coordinating closely with customers and planning for potential timing changes, the company supports households moving during one of the most time-sensitive stages of a property purchase or sale.

Home and family removals represent another core area of operation. These moves frequently involve larger households, increased volumes of furniture and personal belongings, and more detailed planning before moving day. The company stated that structured preparation remains an important part of ensuring household moves are organised efficiently from collection through to delivery.

National relocations complete the company's primary service offering. These longer-distance moves support customers relocating to destinations throughout the United Kingdom. Unlike local moves, which continue to be charged on an hourly basis, national relocations are provided on a set-fee basis, allowing customers to understand costs in advance of the move.

Alessio Giambrone said the new premises will support the continued management of these services as demand evolves. "Every move presents different requirements depending on the property, location, and distance involved. Having a dedicated operational base helps support the planning and coordination needed

to manage those differences effectively.?

The relocation also reflects the company's ongoing commitment to serving communities throughout Sussex. From coastal locations in Brighton and Hove to residential areas further inland, Cheese Removals and Transport continues to support a diverse range of moving requirements. The business reports that local removals remain a significant part of its workload, although requests for national relocations have also increased in recent years.

As part of the move, the company has confirmed that existing services will continue without interruption. Customers booking apartment removals, completion day removals, home and family removals, or national relocations will continue to receive the same service structure currently in place. The relocation affects the company's operational address but does not alter the areas it serves or the range of removal services available.

The new Brighton and Hove premises also position the business to continue supporting customers throughout East and West Sussex. The company stated that maintaining local knowledge remains an important aspect of planning removals in the region, particularly in areas where access restrictions, parking arrangements, and property layouts can influence moving-day logistics.

Since its establishment, Cheese Removals and Transport has focused on providing practical removal services for households moving locally and nationally. The relocation to 3 Fernwood Rise continues that approach, providing a new operational base while allowing the company to maintain its existing service offering.

The company noted that the move forms part of its broader commitment to reviewing how operations are organised as demand for residential removals changes over time. While the relocation marks a change of address, the business stated that its focus remains on coordinating household moves across Sussex and supporting customers through the practical challenges associated with relocation.

Cheese Removals and Transport confirmed that operations are now fully established at the new Brighton and Hove premises. The company will continue providing apartment removals, completion day removals, home and family removals, and national relocations from its new address while supporting customers across the region and throughout the United Kingdom.
