



Indoor Birthday Party Venues See Growing Demand Across the Lower Mainland

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Richmond's 18,000-square-foot interactive play centre offers all-inclusive children's party packages as families seek structured indoor celebration options.

Birthday party venues that combine structured entertainment with all-inclusive amenities are drawing increased interest from families across Metro Vancouver, as parents look for alternatives to home-based celebrations and outdoor venues affected by seasonal weather. Indoor play centres that offer dedicated party spaces, built-in activities, and full-service catering are becoming a preferred choice for families planning milestone events for young children.

The World of Kidtropolis, an 18,000-square-foot interactive miniature city and indoor playground in Richmond, has been operating since 2016 and offers birthday party packages that include a private party room, two hours of play access, food and beverages, and full setup and cleanup. The facility features multiple career-themed play zones where children can role-play as firefighters, grocery store workers, airline pilots, and restaurant staff in a controlled indoor environment.

"Kidtropolis is a very unique place with a lot of potential," said Aleem Kassam, Owner of Kidtropolis. "We offer experiences that combine purposeful play with hands-on learning, and families are telling us they value having a dedicated space where kids can explore and celebrate together."

Kidtropolis has been recognized as a Gold Winner for Family Favourite Indoor Playzone and Best Birthday Party Venue in the Richmond News Best of Richmond awards. The facility's 18,000 square feet of themed play space includes a grocery store, airport, restaurant, and other community-focused areas designed to encourage imaginative role-play. Each zone is staffed and monitored, with entry and exit gates to maintain a secure environment for children. The facility features dedicated areas including a supermarket stocked with play groceries, a fire station with a child-sized truck, an airport boarding area, and a restaurant kitchen where children can prepare pretend meals. Each zone is designed to support different developmental skills, from social cooperation in group activities to fine motor skills through hands-on play. The indoor play sector has become a go-to option for Richmond families organizing milestone celebrations, with facilities that offer structured activities and dedicated hosting spaces gaining particular traction among parents of young children. The venue's combination of structured play, party hosting, and seasonal programming has made it a year-round destination for Richmond-area families with young children.

Party packages range from \$349 for smaller groups of up to eight children on weekdays to \$1,149 for larger parties of up to 28 children on weekends and holidays. Each package includes a dedicated party host, private room access, and food service so that parents can focus on the celebration rather than logistics. Additional options such as themed decorations, face painting, and entertainer partnerships are available through the venue's vendor network. Party hosts coordinate timing for food service, cake cutting, and gift opening, allowing families to stay on schedule without managing logistics themselves..

The indoor children's entertainment market in British Columbia has expanded substantially over the past decade, with facilities adding structured programming, camp services, and party hosting to their core open-play offerings. This shift reflects changing family priorities toward venues that offer both entertainment and developmental value in a single visit.

The children's indoor entertainment sector has seen steady growth across the Lower Mainland, with facilities expanding their offerings beyond open play to include structured party services, camp programs, and after-school care. Kidtropolis also operates a Summer Break Kids Camp and a Clubhouse after-school program, serving families year-round.
