The material is kiln-dried to five-to-eight percent moisture content and hand-processed using a patent-pending treatment to create textures and colors that replicate the look of aged barnwood. This controlled approach ensures consistent quality, dimensional stability, and availability without the variability and preparation requirements of reclaimed wood.

Standard sliding barn doors and interior pre-hung options form part of the lineup, with larger custom sizes available through project-specific quoting. Finishes include traditional deep brown shades, red barn tones, patina and century grays, farmhouse white variations, and special orders such as burnt black. These doors integrate with the company's broader selection of products for coordinated installations.

The milestone reflects growing interest in the rustic design market segment. Sliding barn doors and the emergence of the Forever Barnwood Interior Prehung Doors and Millwork packages have also contributed to the 10,000 door milestone. Projects have incorporated the doors alongside other elements in new construction and renovation work, supporting efficient timelines through factory-direct delivery and ready-to-install condition.
