



SoftPro Water Systems Announces Enhanced Water Treatment Solutions for San Jose CA Residents Facing Variable Water Hardness

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SoftPro Water Systems announced today the expansion of its water treatment technology to address the significant variations in water hardness levels experienced across San Jose, California neighborhoods, where mineral content can range from 7 grains per gallon to over 25 grains per gallon depending on water source composition.

Recent data from Santa Clara Valley Water District and San Jose Water Company indicates that water hardness varies substantially across the city based on the blend of imported surface water and local groundwater sources. Neighborhoods relying heavily on groundwater sources, particularly in valley-floor locations including North San Jose, Berryessa, and Evergreen, experience hardness levels exceeding 25 grains per gallon, placing these areas in the very hard water classification. Surface-water-fed areas typically measure around 7 grains per gallon.

The variation in water hardness creates technical challenges for residential water treatment. Higher mineral content leads to scale accumulation in plumbing systems and water-using appliances, while San Jose's use of chloramine as a primary disinfectant requires specialized filtration approaches. Homeowners commonly report scale buildup on fixtures and inside water heaters, spotty dishes, dry skin and hair after showering, and reduced appliance lifespan.

"Water treatment requirements differ significantly based on local water source composition and treatment methods," said Mark Henderson, Technical Director at SoftPro Water Systems. "Our engineering team has developed systems that address both high mineral content and chloramine disinfection, which are common characteristics in San Jose's municipal water supply."

The company's water softening systems incorporate upflow regeneration technology, which operates differently from conventional downflow softeners by reducing salt and water consumption. The units feature digital control valves with automatic scheduling capabilities that adjust regeneration cycles based on water consumption patterns. The systems utilize chloramine-resistant resin materials designed to maintain effectiveness in chloramine-treated water supplies.

The company provides sizing calculators and technical specifications to assist in system selection based on household size, water usage patterns, and local water quality parameters. Installation requirements vary based on existing plumbing configurations and local building codes. Hard water also affects the performance of soaps and detergents, typically requiring increased product usage to achieve desired cleaning results.
