The Rio Grande corridor along the county's southern boundary provides additional recreational opportunities, including scenic drives along Farm to Market Road 1088, which parallels the river and offers dramatic views of both the Chihuahuan Desert and the Sierra Madre Oriental mountains across the border. The historic town of Fort Hancock serves as a gateway to these remote areas while providing basic services for travelers exploring the region.
