



Government Auction Highlights Outdoor Recreation With Undeveloped Land in Elko County Nevada

Government Auction has released a new regional profile examining the outdoor recreation resources found in areas where the company offers undeveloped land, beginning with Elko County, Nevada. The profile is part of an ongoing informational series describing the public natural attractions located within the regions represented across the company's national land inventory.

Government Auction operates an online marketplace offering undeveloped land throughout the United States. According to the company, the initial installment focuses on Elko County because the surrounding region is recognized for extensive public lands, mountain terrain, and wildlife habitat documented by federal and state agencies. Elko County is situated in the northeastern corner of Nevada and covers roughly 17,000 square miles, making it one of the largest counties in the country by area, according to United States Census Bureau data.

The profile draws on information published by public agencies. Portions of the Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, administered by the United States Forest Service, extend into the county and include the Ruby Mountains and the Ruby Mountains Scenic Area. The Forest Service identifies the Lamoille Canyon Scenic

Byway as a route offering access to hiking trailheads, camping areas, and mountain overlooks. The Bureau of Land Management administers additional public acreage across the county that is open for a range of outdoor pursuits. The United States Fish and Wildlife Service manages the Ruby Lake National Wildlife Refuge, located south of the Ruby Mountains, which the agency describes as a stop for migratory birds and a location for wildlife observation. The Nevada Department of Wildlife lists mule deer, elk, pronghorn, upland birds, and waterfowl among species found in the region.

The company noted that the public lands, recreational attractions, and wildlife resources referenced in the profile are not necessarily adjacent to, or accessible from, individual parcels offered through the marketplace. Proximity, access, and other characteristics vary by region, and the profile is intended to describe the broader area rather than any specific parcel of undeveloped land in Elko County Nevada.

The series also addresses hunting as a long-standing outdoor tradition in the American West. According to the company, hunting in regions such as northeastern Nevada has historically encouraged conservation, respect for wildlife, responsible stewardship of natural resources, and time spent outdoors with family and friends. The profile frames these activities as part of the cultural and recreational heritage of the region rather than as guidance on equipment or technique.

The company stated that additional regional profiles are planned for other counties represented in its inventory. Each installment is intended to summarize publicly documented outdoor resources, including national forests, Bureau of Land Management holdings, wildlife management areas, and scenic byways, so that readers can understand the outdoor character of the surrounding area. The company added that wildlife observation and hunting are among the recreational activities documented by state agencies in northeastern Nevada.

"Government Auction is committed to helping people discover regions where outdoor recreation, wildlife, conservation, and appreciation for America's natural landscapes continue to inspire meaningful experiences," said Ray L. Perry, Marketing Director. "This series is meant to provide context about the areas where the company offers land in Elko County Nevada and elsewhere, drawing on information from the public agencies that manage these resources."
