According to Arkansas State Parks, the Spring River is fed by Mammoth Spring, which the National Park Service and Arkansas State Parks identify as one of the largest springs in the Ozarks, discharging an average of approximately nine million gallons of water per hour. The river's steady, cool current supports canoeing and kayaking, and the nearby South Fork of the Spring River provides additional water access within the region.

State fisheries information from the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission notes that the Spring River is

managed as a trout fishery below Mammoth Spring, while smallmouth bass are present in area streams. The surrounding countryside, according to the same agency, supports populations of deer, turkey, and waterfowl. Mammoth Spring State Park, located a short distance north of the county line, preserves the spring and provides public walking trails and picnic areas, according to Arkansas State Parks.

Beyond its rivers, the region includes public access for hiking, and scenic drives through the Ozark landscape of bluffs, hardwood forests, and pastureland. GovernmentAuction.com states that these publicly documented outdoor resources are among the reasons the company has added land in Fulton County Arkansas to its listings, positioning the parcels alongside properties it offers in other regions recognized for natural surroundings.

The company reports that many of the areas where it lists property share comparable characteristics, ranging from mountain regions in the West to river valleys in the South.
