

Platelet Rich Plasma Injection in Beverly Hills Supports Healing

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Healing after oral surgery depends on many factors, including the body's natural ability to repair tissue. As more patients seek treatment options that work alongside those natural processes, regenerative materials prepared from a patient's own blood have become an established part of many oral surgery procedures. At Los Angeles Oral and Facial Surgery, platelet rich plasma injection in Beverly Hills is part of a broader approach to supporting recovery after procedures such as tooth extractions, bone grafting, and dental implant placement through the use of platelet-rich fibrin, commonly known as PRF.

PRF is created from a small sample of the patient's blood collected before surgery. After the blood is processed, it forms a fibrin matrix containing platelets, white blood cells, and growth factors that are applied directly to the surgical site. Because the material comes from the patient's own blood, no foreign substances are introduced during the process. The fibrin structure gradually releases healing proteins over time, allowing the material to remain active at the treatment site longer than other platelet-based preparations.

Interest in biologic materials has continued to grow across oral and maxillofacial surgery as providers look for ways to support tissue regeneration while working within the body's normal healing response. Platelet-rich fibrin is frequently incorporated into procedures involving bone grafts, dental implants, and surgical extractions because it can be placed directly where healing is taking place. Rather than serving as a replacement for established surgical techniques, PRF functions as an additional material used alongside carefully planned treatment.

At Los Angeles Oral and Facial Surgery, Dr. Tow prepares platelet-rich fibrin during the patient's procedure so the material can be applied immediately after it is processed. This allows the regenerative matrix to be positioned precisely where surgical treatment has occurred. The practice incorporates PRF when appropriate, based on the patient's treatment plan and clinical needs, with the goal of supporting normal tissue healing throughout the recovery process.

The growing awareness of regenerative dentistry has also led many patients to ask about platelet rich plasma

injection in Beverly Hills when researching oral surgery options. While the term platelet-rich plasma is commonly recognized, platelet-rich fibrin differs because it creates a fibrin network that provides a slower release of naturally occurring growth factors over time. This distinction has made PRF an important consideration for many oral surgery procedures where supporting tissue regeneration is part of overall treatment planning.

Patients considering oral surgery often benefit from discussing available treatment options before scheduling a procedure. During consultations, surgeons can explain how biologic materials such as PRF may fit within an individual's treatment plan based on the procedure being performed and the patient's oral health needs. Understanding the role of these materials allows patients to make informed decisions while preparing for surgery and recovery.
