

CVS Decks & Docks Expands Dock and Seawall Construction

ORLANDO, FL - July 27, 2026 -

CVS Decks & Docks, a minority-owned marine construction company, has expanded its dock and seawall construction services for residential and commercial waterfront property owners across Central Florida. The company builds and maintains waterfront structures under Florida Certified General Contractor license CGC1534127, led by founder Camille Asmar.

The expansion responds to steady waterfront development across the region's lakes, canals, and waterways, where docks and seawalls face constant exposure to water, sun, and storm conditions. CVS Decks & Docks works with homeowners, businesses, property managers, and waterfront communities on structures engineered for local shoreline and water conditions rather than built to a single template.

Central Florida presents a specific set of conditions for anything built on the water. Intense year-round ultraviolet exposure, high humidity, heavy summer rainfall, and the Atlantic hurricane season all place sustained stress on waterfront structures, while the region's sandy soils and high lakefront water tables shape how a foundation must be designed. Structures that are not detailed for those conditions tend to show wear, movement, or hardware failure well before the end of their expected service life, which is the gap the company's marine focus is meant to close.

As a licensed general contractor, the company manages each project from design consultation and 3D modeling through permitting, foundation work, framing, and final build. That single-source process is intended to keep waterfront projects aligned with local code and permitting requirements, including the environmental and water-management approvals that dock and seawall work often requires. Handling those approvals in-house is meant to reduce the delays and coordination gaps that can occur when permitting is left to the property owner.

"Every waterfront project starts as marine construction, because the water sets the terms," said Camille

Asmar, founder of CVS Decks & Docks. "A dock or a seawall has to perform in conditions that shift with the weather and the season, so the engineering has to come before the finish."

The company builds residential and commercial docks in floating, stationary, lift, and custom configurations, using pressure-treated lumber and low-maintenance composite. Dock services include installation, framing, repair, piling work, hardware replacement, storm-damage restoration, and boat lift installation and repair, along with dock roofs and routine maintenance such as inspection, cleaning, sealing, and seasonal adjustment. The company frames regular maintenance as a way to identify minor issues before they develop into larger structural concerns, which can extend the service life of a dock over time.

Seawall work is a core part of the company's marine focus and one of the more specialized areas it covers. CVS Decks & Docks installs vinyl seawalls and provides seawall repair and maintenance, with each design assessed for the soil, water depth, and wave exposure of the specific shoreline. A seawall stabilizes the shoreline and reduces the effects of wave action and soil movement, and addressing erosion or structural issues early can help waterfront owners avoid more extensive shoreline damage and preserve the long-term value of their property.

Before construction begins, the company produces a 3D model of each project so property owners can review the layout, materials, and finishes together and make adjustments during the design stage rather than after the build is underway. That planning step is intended to give owners a clearer understanding of how a finished dock, seawall, or deck will fit their shoreline and how it will be used.

The company holds a TrexPro Gold certification and is a certified installer for Fiberon, Deckorators, and MoistureShield, and it works with composite and PVC systems from Trex, TimberTech by AZEK, Fiberon, Deckorators, MoistureShield, Wolf, and WearDeck. Completed projects carry a two-year workmanship warranty, and manufacturer material warranties extend up to 50 years depending on the products selected.

The same waterfront experience carries into the company's deck work, where CVS Decks & Docks builds residential and commercial decks in composite, PVC, and wood, positioned as a complement to its core dock and seawall construction.

CVS Decks & Docks serves waterfront property owners across Orange, Seminole, Lake, Osceola, and Volusia counties, including Orlando, Winter Park, Windermere, Clermont, Kissimmee, Lake Nona, Lake Mary, Sanford, and Mount Dora. The company adapts its construction methods and material selections to the conditions found across Central Florida's lakefront and canal-front communities.
