

Bevilacqua Deck Builders Focuses on Custom Deck Construction

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Bevilacqua Deck Builders, a family-owned deck and outdoor living contractor owned by Anthony Bevilacqua, is concentrating its work on custom composite, PVC, and wood deck construction across eastern and central Massachusetts. The company serves the region from offices in Needham and Medway and builds decks along with the outdoor living spaces that surround them.

Founded in 2017, the company is led by owner Anthony Bevilacqua, who brings more than 15 years of experience in construction and remodeling. Before concentrating on deck building, he worked across home renovation and new home construction, and that background now informs how the company approaches structure and site conditions. It has completed more than 100 projects and builds decks, porches, and related outdoor living structures for residential and commercial clients.

Each project follows the same path from design through the final walkthrough. Work begins with a design consultation and a 3D model that lets homeowners review layout, materials, and railing choices before construction starts. Seeing the project rendered in advance helps homeowners make decisions early, when changes are simple, rather than during the build. From there the company handles foundation work, permitting, framing, and the full build, using wood, steel, aluminum, composite, or pressure-treated LVL framing set on concrete footings, helical piers, or Diamond Piers.

Material selection is shaped by the New England climate. Heavy snow loads, ice, freeze-thaw cycling, and humid summers all wear on outdoor structures, and the company matches decking and structure to those conditions. It works with composite, PVC, and wood decking, including pressure-treated lumber, cedar, redwood, and exotic hardwoods such as Ipe, Tigerwood, and Cumaru, and sets footings below the state frost line to guard against heave. Matching the right material and footing to each property is central to how the company builds for durability.

"Staying focused on decks and outdoor living is what lets us build for this climate the right way," said Anthony Bevilacqua, owner of Bevilacqua Deck Builders. "Every project starts with a 3D model so a homeowner can see the finished space, and the structure underneath it is built for New England winters, not just the view."

Beyond the deck surface, the company builds railings in materials that include wood, composite, glass, aluminum, and cable, along with deck lighting and under-deck systems that turn the space below an elevated deck into a dry, usable area. Its outdoor living work extends to porches, screened and covered porches, three-season rooms, sunrooms, pergolas, louvered pergolas, cabanas, patios, outdoor kitchens, fireplaces, privacy screens, and gazebos. These structures are planned together with the deck so the finished result functions as one cohesive outdoor living space rather than a set of separate additions.

As a TrexPro, TimberTech Pro, and Deckorators certified contractor, the company installs products from those manufacturers along with Fiberon, MoistureShield, and Duralife. Those certifications reflect manufacturer installation training and qualify installations for the manufacturers' material warranty coverage, which runs up to 50 years on qualifying composite systems. The company also builds deck repairs, resurfacing, and additions that extend the life of existing decks.

Anthony Bevilacqua said the company's direction remains centered on deck and outdoor living work across its Needham and Medway service areas, which reach communities throughout Norfolk, Middlesex, Worcester, Plymouth, and Suffolk counties. "The goal is to be the deck builder people in this area think of first," he said. "Concentrating on one type of work is how a company gets better at it over time."

The company reports that demand for low-maintenance composite and PVC decking has continued to grow among Massachusetts homeowners, a shift it attributes to the region's demanding weather and the reduced upkeep those materials require compared with traditional wood.

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
