



Hancock Renovation Introduces In-House Interior Remodeling Line

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Hancock Renovation South Shore, a licensed general contractor based in Quincy, Massachusetts, has introduced a dedicated interior remodeling service line that manages kitchen, bathroom, basement, and room renovations with a single in-house design and construction team. The service consolidates planning, material selection, permitting, and construction under one contractor for homeowners across the South Shore region of Massachusetts.

The interior remodeling line brings together four core categories of residential renovation: kitchen remodels, bathroom renovations, basement finishing, and bonus or home-office room conversions. Rather than subcontracting separate trades, the company assigns design planning, cabinetry, plumbing, electrical work, tile installation, and finish carpentry to employees who report to one project manager. That structure is intended to keep scheduling and quality consistent from the first consultation through the final walkthrough.

The move formalizes a model that emphasizes code compliance and coordinated permitting. Structural changes, plumbing upgrades, electrical work, basement finishing, and egress windows each require permits that vary by Massachusetts municipality, and the company states that its team coordinates those approvals

as part of project planning. Consolidating the work under one licensed contractor is meant to reduce the handoffs that can delay multi-trade renovations.

"The interior remodeling division places design and construction with the same in-house team, so a homeowner works with one point of contact rather than several separate trades," said Bob Dougherty, owner of Hancock Renovation South Shore. "The intent is to keep a project organized and the schedule predictable from planning through completion."

Project timelines under the new line are defined in advance during a design phase. According to the company, a typical bathroom remodel runs about two to four weeks, a kitchen remodel about four to eight weeks, and basement finishing roughly four to twelve weeks depending on complexity, with a detailed timeline issued before construction begins. The initial in-home consultation is offered at no cost and no obligation, and material selection, covering options such as quartz, granite, and porcelain surfaces, custom cabinetry, and updated fixtures, is completed before ordering. In many single-room projects, homeowners can remain in the residence during construction through the use of organized work areas and dust-control measures.

The service line follows a five-stage process that starts with a free in-home consultation and continues through a detailed estimate, permitting and pre-construction scheduling, construction managed by a dedicated point of contact, and a final walkthrough to confirm completed work. The company reports more than ten years of operation in the region and service to 27 or more communities, among them Quincy, Plymouth, Hingham, Duxbury, Scituate, Hanover, Brockton, Norwell, and Marshfield.

Hancock Renovation South Shore, which operates online under the South Shore Home Remodel name, holds Massachusetts contractor licensing and carries liability insurance on each project. The firm received a 2024 Quality Business Award tied to a customer rating above 95, a recognition it cites in connection with the interior remodeling offering.

The company also indicated that the interior line can coordinate multi-room projects, such as combined kitchen and living-space renovations or paired basement and bathroom work, to streamline scheduling across a single household. Crews work on single-family houses, multi-family properties, and older New England homes, with each residence assessed individually for structural conditions and layout options. Wall removal, layout reconfiguration, and open-concept changes are evaluated for load-bearing conditions and engineering requirements during planning, before any construction starts.

"Bundling several rooms into one managed schedule reduces repeated disruption for a household and keeps the design consistent across spaces," said Dougherty. "That coordination is the reason the interior remodeling work now sits within one division."
